III. REQUEST TO REMAIN IN ASRS/CORP

1. **Deliz Nunez** is requesting to remain in ASRS; she has 5.327 years of service. She laterally transferred to a CORP position as a Correctional Education Program Teacher effective April 15, 2023.

IV. DISABILITY RETIREMENTS

Discussion and possible action for the following matters at various stages of the Disability Retirement Pension application process:

1. **Billy Wilson:** Rehearing on the February 2, 2023 approval for Ordinary Disability Pension per request by PSPRS.
2. **Connie Collins:** Rehearing on the December 1, 2022, denial for Ordinary Disability Pension, per requested by Connie Collins.

V. RETURN TO WORK RETIREES WITH AN ASSIGNMENT CHANGE REQUESTING TO RETAIN PENSION

Discussion and possible action on a request to retain pensions:

1. Tara Diaz retired from CORP effective December 29, 2012. She returned to work in an ASRS position as a Bureau Support Administrator. She was promoted to another ASRS position as a Contract Beds Operations Administrator effective October 4, 2014. She was promoted to another ASRS position as Regional Operations Administrator effective August 04, 2018. She was promoted to a CORP position as Assistant Director effective July 13, 2019, to January 10, 2020. She accepted a CORP position as a Deputy Director effective February 21, 2023. Ms. Diaz is requesting to retain her CORP pension. An Alternate Contribution Rate is required.

VI. GENERAL DISCUSSION

Discussion and possible action on the following matters listed in this section:

1. Seeking Clarification from IME Doctor regarding Kanday Matzdorff: PSPRS is requesting a rehearing of the Local CORP Board's decision to approve Kanday Matzdorff's ordinary disability pension. PSPRS provided multiple reasons for this rehearing request, including that there appeared to be a contradiction in the IME Doctor's finding that the injury occurred prior to CORP membership while also finding that there was no pre-existing condition or injury contributing to the claimed disability. Instructions and approval from the Local Board are sought on whether to seek clarification from the IME Doctor regarding his findings.

public comment is limited to addressing criticism, asking staff to review a matter, or asking that a matter be put on a future agenda.
