He is requesting to retain his CORP pension. An Alternate Contribution Rate is required.

She promoted to a Correctional Officer II, effective December 20, 2023. She lateral transferred to a different unit as a full-time Correctional Officer II effective July 6, 2024. She is requesting to retain her CORP pension. An Alternate Contribution Rate is required.
- **5. Ricardo Luna** retired from CORP effective November 30, 2018. He returned to work in a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Officer II, effective February 20, 2024. He lateral transferred to a different unit at as a full-time Correctional Officer II effective July 6, 2024. He is requesting to retain his CORP pension. An Alternate Contribution Rate is required.
