- **4. Cynthia Tejeda:** New Application for Total and Permanent Disability Pension.
- 5. Xavier Castillo: Possible vote on whether to close this disability pension application/matter: Mr. Castillo applied for a CORP Accidental Disability pension in September 2024, and he terminated employment with ADCRR, effective November 22, 2024. The Local Board approved Mr. Castillo to be scheduled for an IME. Subsequently, Mr. Castillo notified the Board Secretaries that he was rolling over his CORP contributions out of the fund, and after Board Secretary Ray informed him that he would no longer be eligible for a CORP disability pension if he rolled his funds out of the membership, Mr. Castillo confirmed he was moving forward with the rollover. On 12/26/24 the Board Secretaries received an email from Nationwide that Mr. Castillo did refund his contributions on 12/12/24.

# V. RETURN TO WORK RETIREE REQUESTING TO RETAIN PENSION Discussion and possible action on the following requests to retain pensions:

- 1. Alfred Martinez retired from CORP effective November 30, 2018. He returned to work in a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Officer II, effective January 8, 2024. Then, he was promoted to a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Lieutenant, effective November 9, 2024. He is requesting to retain his CORP pension. An Alternate Contribution Rate is required.
- **2. Emelio Ruiz** retired from CORP effective February 21, 2020. He returned to work in a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Officer I, effective November 6, 2023. Then, he was promoted to a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Officer II, effective December 20, 2023. Then, he was promoted to a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Sergeant, effective August 31, 2024. Then, he was promoted to a full-time CORP position as a Correctional Lieutenant, effective November 9, 2024. He is requesting to retain his CORP pension. An Alternate Contribution Rate is required.
