

MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

ADCRR HAS RELEASED 8,177 INMATES FY 2023 YEAR TO DATE







ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION




TOTAL STAFF ASSAULTED PER 1000 INMATES
